

# Cats End 'Fabulous' Season 20-3

Last night's game at Gooselake showed what an outstanding team MV has, time wasn't on the Cats side as they fell 63-64 to Northeast in overtime after a 51-51 end of regulation tie.

"This was a fabulous season with a conference championship and a 20 win season," commented Coach Rundquist. "These are things many can't say they've accomplished."

Jonathon Thomas led us in scoring with 29 points and 14 boards. Robbie Mohr and Justy Feldt each contributed 12 points. Humpal had eight assists.

"I would like to thank our two seniors (Feldt and Henry) for their hard work and leadership this season," Rundquist stated.

The Cats started district play last Tuesday night at Gooselake against Camanche. The Cats won 69-39. Twenty-one of those points came from three-pointers.

"Camanche attempted to slow the pace of the game and I was extremely happy with how the players

handled that situation," stated Coach Rundquist. "MV stepped up on defense, eliminating the slowdown tactics and limited Camanche to only 21 points through three quarters."

Thomas had 26 points and 11 rebounds. Henry had 14 points and 7 boards. Feldt and Mohr led the Cats with five assists each. Humpal was a threat with five steals.

Last Friday night the Cats traveled to Maquoketa. Fans got their money worth as they got to see the Cats in overtime, but the game ended with the score favoring Maquoketa 68-62.

Mohr led MV with 20 points and seven assists. Thomas was also in double figures with 16 points and 10 rebounds. The Cats ended the season 20-3 overall and 15-1 in the conference.

Coach Rundquist ended, "Just a short 262 days and we get to start again."
