Our Maquoketa Valley Wildcats hold an overall record of 2-1 after clawing the Cougars last Friday night. The Cats traveled to Cascade and came home victorious. The score was 41-0.

“We are becoming a very coachable football team,” commented Coach Drew. “Our players must be able to accept their role, play as a team, and make adjustments during the game. These guys have embraced that and that is why they are successful.”

The Wildcats had a total of 247 rushing yards at the game. Justy Feldt and Blake Humpal made up the total of 119 passing yards. The Cascade Cougars didn't score during any quarter that evening.

“Our special teams players are excited to show their stuff,” Coach Drew stated. “Coach Huegel has gotten them to race to the ball carrier and limit our opponent's returns.”

Mike Sibel led in receiving with 43 yards making one touch down. Shawn Roling also made a touch down with a total of 34 yards. Right behind them was Jonny Thomas with 28 yards, Tristan Miles with nine yards, and Robbie Mohr with five yards.

“Our offense moved the ball successfully on the ground and through the air,” said Coach Drew. “Eight players rushed the ball for a total of 247 yards and five receivers caught the ball from our quarterbacks.”

Brent Klostermann was the leader in rushing with a total of 67 yards. Mohr followed him with 43 yards. Dustin Helmrichs made two touch downs at the game and achieved a total of 41 yards. Quarterbacks Feldt and Humpal continued the with 35 and 24 yards. Nathan Burger totaled 21 yards and Travis Klostermann made one touch down and reached a total of 13 yards. Dustin Glew rushed three yards at the game.

Coach Drew remarked, “We did an excellent job of playing team defense. Every member of our team got quality playing time and, I thought, made the most of their opportunities.”

Jake Norlin led the defense with seven tackles. Right behind him were Brent Klostermann and Glew, each with six tackles. Jacob Bawek made five tackles and Burger made four and also had one quarterback sack. Nick Smock also had four tackles. Travis Klostermann achieved three tackles and had one interception while Travis Mollenhauer also had three tackles and one quarterback sack. Chad Ries, Jeremy Ronnebaum, and Feldt all had three tackles. Several players made two tackles: Mike Sibel, Brian Hillebrand, Humpal, Thomas, Miles, Mohr, and Helmrichs. Also, Thomas made one interception at the game. Lee Manson had one tackle and one fumble recovery at the game. Shawn Roling was another player achieving a quarterback sack and he had one tackle. Other team members making one tackle were Scott Conrad, Doug Nadermann, and Andrew Kracke.
