On April 13th the Girls Golf team golfed against West Delaware at the Manchester Golf Club. MV had a team score of 235 and West Delaware had a team score of 238. Michelle Tumey was a medalist with a 49.

Michelle was the top MV golfer and Ashleigh Hunt followed with a 55 and Jessi Preussner a 65. Sheila Wenthold got a 66, Melissa Schultz followed closely with a 67 and Annie Ehltz got a 76.

April 14th the girls golf team traveled to the Backbone Country Club at Strawberry Point. MV finished second with a score of 227. Oelwein got the winning score of 201 and Starmont placed third with a 240. Tiffany Hoskins from Oelwein was the medalist with a 48.

The top golfers for MV were Tumey with a 51, Hunt with a 55 and Preussner a 57. Wenthold got a 64, Ehltz a 73 and Schultz a 76.
