

SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board of Directors of the Maquoketa Valley Community School District derives its legal status from the constitution of the State of Iowa and the statutes enacted by the General Assembly. The Board of Directors acts as an agent of the state in developing an educational program in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Iowa.

The Board of Directors shall consist of five members. Each member of the Board of Directors is elected for a term of four years or to complete the unexpired term of a regularly elected member. (See 201.060)
