

LEGAL COUNSEL

The diverse scope of school board decisions and business can have immense implications. Many times it is necessary for the Board and the Superintendent to seek specialized and expert opinions as part of the information to be used in board decision making. To this end, the Board may employ or retain individuals who have been admitted to practice law in this state to serve as legal, administrative advisors to the Board and the Superintendent.

The legal advisors will render administrative advice, conduct or assist with the conduct of school district litigation, and provide specialized legal service. The legal advisors may be required to attend board meetings or other activities when their services are needed.
