

COMPLIMENTARY PASSES FOR SCHOOL EVENTS

The following individuals shall be issued passes for free admission to all Maquoketa Valley sponsored school activities:

A. General:

1. Board members and spouse, if married. If Board member unmarried, for Board member and friend when accompanied by Board member.
2. Administrators and spouse, if married. If administrator unmarried, for administrator and friend when accompanied by administrator.
3. Teacher and spouse, if married. If unmarried, for teacher and friend when accompanied by teacher.
4. Classified employees, permanent or temporary, who work four or more hours per day and at least 180 days per year shall receive a pass for themselves and their spouse. If unmarried, the pass may be used by the employee and friend when accompanied by the employee.
5. Classified employees, permanent or temporary, who work less than four hours per day but at least 180 days per year shall receive a pass for themselves only.
6. Designated lay people who provide free service to the school (such as full-time scorekeepers/timekeepers, etc.)
7. Senior citizens, age 65 or older, and a resident of this school district.

B. Life Time Passes:

1. Any elected board member who has served three or more years as director of this school district. The pass shall be for the ex-board member and spouse. If former Board member unmarried, for former Board member and friend when accompanied by Board member.
2. Any retired Maquoketa Valley employee who completed ten or more years of employment in the Maquoketa Valley Community School District. The pass shall be for the retired employee and spouse. If unmarried, for former employee and friend.

C. Other:

1. Special lifetime passes may be issued to any person, who in the judgment of the school board, has rendered such outstanding service to the local school district as to justify such an honor.

D. Students:

1. Those students who are participating in the event or in case of athletes, those students who are eligible to "dress" for said activity. All other students must pay the regular student admission.
