

**STUDENT ACTIVITY PROGRAM**

The Board of Directors believes that students and their parents should be free to choose to participate in activities sponsored by different organizations.

Accordingly, any student in grades 7 through 12 who participates in school-sponsored sport programs may participate in non-school-sponsored sport programs during the same season. Such outside participation, however, shall not conflict with the school sponsored athletic activity. Moreover, a student who chooses to give non-school participation priority over the school-sponsored sport program may jeopardize his or her status or standing as a member of the school-sponsored sport program.

Communication among the athlete, parents and coaches is critically important in ensuring that conflicts do not arise.
