

HOMEWORK

In planning homework, the teacher should know something of the child's activities outside of school. Factors or agencies other than the school are educative, and there are times when other activities are more vital to the child's development than the teacher's assignment.

Teachers may give homework to students to aid in their development. The type, frequency, and quantity of homework assigned should be determined by the needs of the individual student and should not normally require parents to supplement instruction. Homework should be an application or adaptation of a classroom experience. It should not be assigned for disciplinary purposes.
