

EXCHANGE TEACHING

For the purposes of securing knowledge of educational methods in other school districts, either inside or outside the United States, and for promoting international goodwill, the Board of Directors may contract with another board or other educational authorities for the exchange of teaching services.

Conditions affecting salary payments and position on the Maquoketa Valley salary schedule shall be as follows: (a) salary increments and also retirement and other benefits shall continue during participation in the program; (b) Maquoketa Valley teachers on exchange service in foreign countries shall receive their regular salary payments from the Maquoketa Valley Community School District unless paid directly by the school system of the country in which they teach; and (c) exchange teacher salary includes no extra compensation for position, such as department head, and no activity payments such as may normally be received at Maquoketa Valley for these services.

Any such requests shall be judged by the Superintendent upon its merits, namely what benefits may be derived through such an exchange.
