

INSUFFICIENT CLASSROOM SPACE

Insufficient classroom space exists when conditions adversely affect the implementation of the educational philosophy and program of the Board of Directors. The Board shall determine insufficient classroom space on a case by case basis. Criteria to be used by the Board in its determination may include, but not be limited to, available personnel, grade level, educational program, instructional method, physical space, equipment and materials available, finances available, facilities either being planned or currently under construction, sharing agreements in force, bargaining agreements in force, and district goals and objectives.
