PROGRESS REPORTS OF STUDENTS

Reporting Practices:

The Board of Directors recognizes the following objectives or purposes of a system of student reporting practices:

- 1. To inform parents of the progress made by their children.
- 2. To bring parents into closer understanding of the work of the school.
- 3. To record for pupils their growth or achievement.
- 4. To assist pupils in evaluating their growth or achievement.
- 5. To assist the pupil, his/her parents, and the school in working cooperatively for the welfare of the pupil.

Parent-teacher conferences shall be scheduled for all students, JK-12, two times per year. The first conference shall follow the end of the first quarter and the second conference shall follow the end of the third quarter.

Deficiency reports will be mailed parents/guardians if requested.

Report cards shall be issued for all students at the close of each of the four quarters of the school year.
