

REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS RIDING SCHOOL BUSES

1. School buses are provided by the Maquoketa Valley Community Schools District for the safety and convenience in transporting our students to and from school.
2. The driver of the bus is in charge. Pupils must obey the driver promptly and cheerfully.
3. The driver may assign a seat for each pupil. Pupils may move to a second assigned seat after the passenger load is lightened if permission is first obtained from the driver and the bus is not in motion.
4. Pupils must be on time. The bus cannot wait for those who are tardy.
5. Pupils must not throw waste paper or other rubbish on the floor. Help keep the bus clean and sanitary at all times.
6. Pupils must not extend arms or head or throw anything out of bus windows.
7. Pupils must not do anything to distract the driver. Remember your safety depends on him/her.
8. Pupils who have to cross the road before entering or after leaving the bus must do so in front of the bus after making sure the highway is clear.
9. Pupils are asked to be courteous and kind to each other and older pupils are asked to look after the safety of younger pupils.
10. Any pupil who insists on violating these rules will be reported to the principal who can deny you the privilege of riding on the bus.
