

FIRST AID

Students who become ill or are injured at school will be given first aid. Whenever possible, parents will be notified by phone and instructions will be requested as to the disposal of the case. When the parent has no telephone or cannot be reached, the ill or injured child shall be transported home, to the hospital, or to a doctor's office by a member of the school staff.

In cases of emergency, the pupil shall be transported to a hospital or a doctor's office by ambulance or other convenient types of transportation. If possible the family physician listed on the office records shall be contacted.

The Board assumes no responsibility for medical treatment of students. Students who must take prescribed medication during school hours shall follow the procedures outlined in Board Policies 504.120, 504.121, and 504.122.
