

DISASTER RECOVERY PLAN

The Maquoketa Valley Community School District's current disaster recovery plan consists of two different back-up systems to secure financial and student data records.

The first back-up plan consists of protecting the districts Software Unlimited Data. That financial data is hosted by Infrastructure Technology Solutions based in Monticello, Iowa. The product to protect the data is ShadowProtect and this product automatically does a full system backup every night at 10:00 p.m. Infrastructure Technology Solutions also employ's a system configured to take a snapshot of the data disk at 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. everyday.

Student information data is hosted by Grantwood Area Education Agency in Cedar Rapids, Iowa through an approved vendor by the Iowa Department of Education. That provider is Power School. This data in Power School is backed up daily.

If a disaster occurred the Maquoketa Valley Community School District would also work in partnership with the Iowa Association of School Boards (IASB) and EMC Insurance to help in the process of system recovery. (Facility attainment, computers, equipment, software, etc.)
