The Board approved the voluntary early separation request from Kris Wilson at the end of the 21-22 school year. The Board, as well as Supt. Hoeger, expressed their appreciation to Mrs. Wilson for her years of service to the district and her dedication to the students of Maquoketa Valley. Mrs. Wilson will truly be missed by everyone.

The Board reviewed and approved the updated 2022-2023 High School Course catalog.

The Board adopted the budget guarantee as follows: RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Maquoketa Valley Community School District will levy property tax for the fiscal year 2022-2023 for the regular program budget adjustment as allowed under Iowa Code section 257.14. Roll call vote was answered all ayes.

The Board reviewed and approved the proposed quote for the greenhouse renovation project from FarmTek in the amount of \$29,361.

The Board suspended the 403 board policy series and will enact these policies again only if a change in legislation dictates they become a requirement.

Preparation for negotiations with the Teacher Association is underway. Further discussion of this will take place at the February meeting.
