Dear Iowa High School,

Simpson College introduced two new full-tuition scholarship programs that are expected to substantially increase the number of new, first-time enrolling students from Iowa who qualify for free tuition in Fall 2024.

Simpson College's **All-In for Iowa** plan consists of The Simpson \$100K Promise and 99 County Full-Tuition programs. Both incorporate federal and state aid awards with Simpson scholarship funds to cover full tuition.

The first initiative, Simpson's \$100K Promise, pledges full-tuition support for admitted students whose family's adjusted gross income is \$100,000 or less. The \$100,000 income threshold represents a 67 percent increase over Simpson's previous Promise program of the past six years.

The second initiative, 99 County Full-Tuition, ensures that at least one admitted student from each of Iowa's 99 counties will be eligible to receive a full-tuition scholarship. Those scholarships will be awarded via a committee selection process, which includes consideration of both financial need and academic merit.

Both first-year students and transfers will be eligible for the programs in Fall 2024. Students must submit a Free Application for Student Financial Aid (FAFSA) and be deemed eligible for federal aid. In addition to being full-time, first-time enrollees at Simpson, students must live on campus and participate in one of the College's meal plans at their expense. Students will be eligible for the \$100K Promise on a rolling admission basis while the 99 County Full-Tuition program will have a priority deadline of February 15, 2024.
