## 2024 Delaware County Dairy Promoters Scholarship Application

The Delaware County Dairy Promoters will award scholarships to three (3) high school seniors in the amount of \$500 each. The recipients must currently live or work on an operating dairy farm within Delaware County, Iowa OR show dairy animals in the dairy 4-H show at the Delaware County Fair.

Payment will be made after the Delaware County Dairy Promoters receives a first semester transcript from the college or university that the recipient is attending. The winner of the 2024 Dairy Promoters Scholarship must use the funds before July 1, 2025, or they will be considered forfeited.

*In the event of sickness or temporary disability:* 

If, after being awarded this scholarship, a student is unable to enroll in college, or the student's attendance is interrupted or delayed due to prolonged illness or injury, the award will be held in reserve. The advice of the college medical service or the attending physician will be taken into account in determining the length of time the award will be held.

Scholarship winners will be honored at our 2024 Delaware County Dairy Banquet, slated to be held March 2, 2025.

## **Eligibility:**

- Applicant must be a member of the graduating 2023 class.
- Applicant must currently live on an operating dairy farm within Delaware County, OR must currently be employed with an operating dairy farm within Delaware County OR shows dairy animals in the dairy 4-H show at the Delaware County Fair.
- Applicant must be planning to enroll at an accredited university, college, or vocational technical institution for a degree program or short course program. **Program of study DOES NOT need to be dairy or agriculture related** in order to be eligible for this scholarship!
