Registration is open now for the ISL Education Lending Scholarship. This is a new sign-up period for a successful program offered in fall 2023. Those who registered for the fall period are encouraged to register again for a new chance to win.

The ISL Education Lending Scholarship is an opportunity for all high school students, not just seniors, to learn about planning and paying for college. In addition, their parents or guardians and current college students may enter. Winners receive deposits into College Savings Iowa accounts so they can choose when and how to use the awards.

Encourage ninth- to 12th-grade students and their parents to enter for a chance to earn one of 45 \$1,000 deposits into a College Savings Iowa 529 account.

About the Scholarship

The scholarship program is open to Iowa residents who are either:

- Iowa high school students.
- Undergraduate college students.
- Parents, guardians or others who hold a College Savings Iowa account benefiting an Iowa high school or undergraduate college student.

Online registration is simple. Your students should:

- 1. Visit www.IowaStudentLoan.org/Enter to register between January 8 and March 29, 2024.
- 2. Provide basic contact information for themselves and their parents or guardians.

After registering, students may continue to read three quick college planning and financing tips and answer a multiple choice question on each.

For the remainder of the scholarship period, registered students receive emailed information on college planning and financing.

Forty-five winners will be drawn from eligible high school, college and parent entries in April. Each winner will receive a \$1,000 deposit into a College Savings Iowa account.

Additional Chances to Win

Each student may enter themselves only once per program period, but a parent or guardian, or another adult who holds College Savings Iowa account naming the student as a beneficiary, may also enter on their student's behalf once per program period.
