Registration is open now for the ISL Education Lending Scholarship. The program is an opportunity for all high school students, not just seniors, to learn about planning and paying for college. In addition, their parents or guardians and current college students may enter. Winners receive deposits into ISave 529 accounts, so they can choose when and how to use the awards.

Encourage ninth- to 12th-grade students and their parents to enter for a chance to earn one of 45 \$1,000 deposits into an ISave 529 account.

About the Scholarship

The scholarship program is open to Iowa residents who are either:

- Iowa high school students.
- Undergraduate college students.
- Parents or guardians of, or others who hold an ISave 529 account benefiting, an Iowa high school or undergraduate college student.

Online registration is simple. Your students should:

- 1. Visit www.IowaStudentLoan.org/Enter to register between now and December 5, 2025.
- 2. Provide basic contact information for themselves and their parents or guardians.

After registering, students may continue to read three quick college planning and financing tips and answer a multiple choice question on each.

For the remainder of the scholarship period, registered students receive emailed information on college planning and financing.

Forty-five winners will be drawn from eligible high school, college and parent entries in December. Each winner will receive a \$1,000 deposit into an ISave 529 account.

Additional Chances to Win

Each student may enter themselves only once per program period, but they have additional opportunities to win an award:

- One parent or guardian, or another adult who holds an ISave 529 account naming the student as a beneficiary, may enter on their student's behalf once per program period.
- Students may register again for the spring program beginning January 5, 2026.
