Dear High School Counselor:

I am enclosing a copy of our 2026 (\$1000.00) Combat Vets Chapter 39-3 Memorial Scholarship application. We ask that you share it with your 2026 graduating high school seniors who are planning to further their education after high school.

We have a few requirements for them to be eligible, with the most important being that they MUST have a relative who is serving or has served in the US Military (ex. - sister, brother, mother, father, grandfather, grandmother, great grandfather, great grandmother etc). Please verify that information with them prior to their getting a copy of our application form.

The student is also required, not only, to submit a completed copy of our Scholarship application form, but also a copy of their acceptance letter from the school of their choice, any letters of recommendation they may have received, and their essay written in 1000 words or less on the subject of "What does the American Flag and our Freedom mean to me? Their military relative's name(s) and military affiliation will need to be on the application form as described at the bottom of the application form.

We ask that each student applying for our scholarship submit their APPLICATION PACKET to you or forward it to me at the above address or email address (in .PDF format) by no later than April 5, 2026. If it gets to be too close to the due date and they need to request an extension on the due date – it will not be accepted - unless I hear from you directly that it is coming (phone, text, or email). Please contact me should you have any questions. We will, then, contact you with the name of our winning candidate(s) from your schools' applicants, once we have met as a group, to select the 2026 Scholarship winners.

We are pleased to announce this year, that due to the generous donations we received this past year from the community, we will be awarding several \$1000 scholarships to graduating seniors who attend local high schools in NE Iowa. It is very important that you get our application out to as many of your eligible graduating seniors in your school, in order for us to be able to award at least one of our \$1000 scholarships. We also ask that you allow US to make the selection of who would receive our scholarship. If you get multiple applications and you have more than one military organization offering scholarships – please have them apply to both organizations. We appreciate your help to us get the applications out and we hope that ALL eligible graduating students be given ALL opportunities to receive as many scholarships as they apply and qualify for.
